## Rules of Play for 50/50 Electronic Raffle:

- 1. The 50/50 online ticket sales start at 6:00am and end up to or before the 60th minute of the match. Tickets are also sold at 'Caps Kickoff, all BC Place Stadium Entrances, on the concourse, in the 300 suite and club level, and in the stands for the duration of the match up to or before the 60th minute of the match.
- 2. The draw is conducted at the BC Place 50/50 office (777 Pacific Blvd, Vancouver, BC V6B 4Y8) after the 75th minute of the match.
- 3. Must be 19 years or older to purchase a 50/50 ticket.
- 4. Must be in British Columbia (BC) at the time of purchase.
- 5. After buying, patrons will receive a confirmation e-mailed with their 50/50 registered numbers from a Random Selection System. No specific numbers can be given as numbers are generated randomly.
- 6. Tickets will be available at online at <u>https://covenanthouseraffle.5050central.com/</u>
- 7. Tickets are 3 for \$10, 20 for \$20, 100 for \$40
- 8. The total tickets for sale are 999,999 at 3 for \$10; 1,000,000 at 20 for \$20; 1,000,000 at 100 for \$40.
- 9. Tickets will be sold using computer software that utilizes an Electronic Raffle System (ERS) GPEB certified software random number generator (RNG), supplied by Ascend Fundraising Solutions.
- 10. The winning number will be announced on game days after the 75<sup>th</sup> minute of the match on Vancouver Whitecaps FC website and their social media channels. In the case of a discrepancy between the announced number and the actual number—the actual number will be considered to be the valid winning ticket. Winning numbers and amounts are also available on Covenant House Vancouver's website at https://www.covenanthousebc.org or by calling Covenant House Vancouver's office at 604-638-GIFT (4438).
- 11. Unclaimed prizes will be secured or placed in safekeeping for a period of one year from the date of the draw. If at that time the prize has not been claimed, the prize or cash equivalent to the fair market value of the prize may be donated to an eligible organization or used towards a similar, future draw when approved by GPEB.
- 12. Only the holder of the winning ticket may claim the prize. Covenant House Vancouver shall have no responsibility to any other person who claims any interest or right to receive all or any part of the prize associated with a winning ticket. The winner will then be paid by cheque for the amount posted at the event for which they bought their ticket. Winners must have the original winning ticket and no copies. *All payments will be made by cheque.* The prize claimant will be required to sign a Declaration and Release ("Release") which must be executed and returned to Covenant House Vancouver no later than five (5) business days after his/her receipt of the Release. In the event a claimant: (a) does not notify CHV within ten (10) days of the drawing; (b) is ruled ineligible for any reason; (c) refuses the prize; or (d) does not return an executed Release, the prize will be forfeited and will be retained by CHV for charitable use. All prizes will be sent to the winners via cheque within thirty (30) days of the winner delivering the winning Raffle Ticket, executed Release, and all other required documents to CHV. - 13. Selection of Winner: Upon the conclusion of the Purchase Period, CHV will use the System to randomly generate one winning ticket number from among the numbers associated with purchased tickets. The Raffle will be conducted by a CHV staff member and supervised by a member of the Board of Directors of CHV, and the decisions of that person shall be final and binding.
- 14. If a situation causes a delay or prevents a draw from occurring CHV will send out a notice of the substitution date via email notification to all ticket buyers and the details posted on the website.
- 15. All ticket sales are final. Once a ticket has been purchased, refunds will not be granted. The only exception would be in the unlikely event the raffle is cancelled. At that point BC Gaming Policy and Enforcement rules and guidelines will be followed for proper reimbursement to all ticket buyers. The liability of the licensee of this raffle shall be limited to the purchase price of the ticket(s).
